#### **TOUR ITINERARY**

#### <u> Day 1 / Seoul – Gongju – Buyeo - Jeonju</u>

Meet your local guide at the assemble place 10 minutes before 8am. Visits to Gongju after 1 hour 30 minutes bus ride, visits to 2 UNESCO sites, The tomb of King Muryeong: is the tomb of the 25th King of Baekjie excavated in Songsan-ri and Gongsanseong Fortress a mountain castle was built between the year of 234 to 678, the reveal of the history of Baekjie. Buyeo, ancient capital of Baekje Dynasty to visit Nakhwaam cliff observatory where 300 court ladies of Baekje plunged into the river to avoid being captured and dishonored on the last of the Kingdom. The next spot is JeonjuHanok Village. There are about 7000 traditional Korean houses called Hanok. Free on your own after check-in the hotel in Jeonju.

Hotel stay: Ramada Jeonju hotel or similar.

#### Day 2 / Jeonju – Gwangju – Suncheon – Yeosu

After breakfast in hotel, the 1st sightseeing spot is the leading city of Honam region and birthplace of a modern democratic movement in Korea, Gwangju, May 18th National Cemetry, history of Korea. The next spot is Suncheon Bay National Garden, a home of over 790,000 trees, in 505 species and 3.15 million flowers in 113 species. After check-in the hotel stay in Yeosu, free on your own.

Hotel stay: Ramada Plaza by Wyndham Yeosu or similar (B)

#### Day 3 / Yeosu – Jinju – Busan

After breakfast in hotel, visit to Jinjuseong Fortress, (area 1760m, stone Castle ) is a sacred ground that integrates the history and culture of Jinju. During the Japanese invasion of Korea in 1592, the General Gim Si-min had a victory at this castle, which was one of the three great victories. Heads to Busan with brief stops at Gimhae airport, and Busan Train station, afterwards, visits to the Jagalchi Fish market, Busan's largest seafood market, then the Haeundae Beach, the Dongbaek Park. Transfer to Gyeongju, free on your own after check-in hotel.

Hotel stay: Commodore Hotel Gyeongju or similar (B)

#### Day 4 / Gyeongju – Andong – Pyeongchang

After breakfast visits to 2 UNESCO sites, Seokguram Grotto and Bulguksa Temple. The beauty of the temple and artistic touch of the stone relics are as awesome and fascinating as to be higly praised by visitors from everywhere. Next spot to visit is the Andong Hahoe Folk Village UNESCO, the whole village has preserved housing architecture and the village structure of the Joseon Dynasty. The whole village was naturally formed with people who actually live there. It became world-famous after the visit of Queen Elizabeth II of Great Britain. Check-in hotel after reaching Pyeongchang, free on your own. *Hotel stay: Ramada Hotel Pyeongchang or similar (B)* 

Day 5 / Pyeongchang – Mt. Seorak – Seoul

After breakfast in hotel, visit the venue of 2018 Winter Olympic Games (Ski Jumping Stadium, not the Tower, then the next sightseeing spot is \*Mt. Seorak National Park, the peaks of the Seoraksan Mountains break through the cluuds while jade-like water flows through the valleys, Breathtaking views everywhere. Many rare species can be found here, the Seorak Mountain has been an UNESCO site as a Biosphere Preservation District since 1982. Cable car ride to Gwongeumseong Fortress is an option, the rate is US\$15 per person. Return to Seoul after a 3 hours ride by the sightseeing bus.

Arrive Seoul about 6pm at the drop off point: Donghwa Duty Free Shop Building at Gwanghwamun intersection. (B)
