TOUR ITINERARY

<u>Day 1 / Seoul – Gongju – Jeonju</u>

Meet a guide at parking lot in front of Donghwa Duty Free Shop Building, at GwanghwamunIntersection,Seoul08:00am \rightarrow Move to Gongju (130Km/ 1hr 30min)- Reveal the history Baekje Dynasty / The Tomb of KingMuryeong(UNESCO) \rightarrow Gongsanseong Fortress(UNESCO), a mountain castle which was established during theBaekje Period (234-678). \rightarrow Trnasfer to Jeonju (80Km/1 hr) to visit JeonjuHanok Village including about 700traditional Korean houses called Hanok. \rightarrow Check-into your hotel and have leisure time.

Hotel stay: Best Western Plus Jeonju Hotel or similar.

Day 2 / Jeonju – Gwangju – Suncheon – Yeosu

Breakfast at your hotel \rightarrow Move to Gwangju (100km/ 1hr 30min), the leading city of Honam region andbirthplace of a modern democratic movement in Korea, May 18th National Cemetery (Gwangju, hometown of BTS member J-Hope and his song "Ma City" contains the May 18 Gwangju Democratization movement.) \rightarrow Move to Suncheon (100km/ 1hr) where you will visit Suncheo Bay National Garden \rightarrow Move to Yeosu (38km/40min), a romantic coastal city and look around the Yi Sun-shin Plaza \rightarrow Check in a hotel.

Hotel stay: Ramada Plaza by Wyndham Yeosu or similar (B)

Day 3 / Yeosu – Jinju – Busan - Gyeongju

Breakfast at your hotel \rightarrow Jinjuseong Fortress – historically linked to Japanese invasion in 1592. \rightarrow Move to Busan (100Km/1.5hrs) \rightarrow Arrive at Gimhae domestic airport \rightarrow Depart from Gimhae (1st floor,Ticket office of the bus) \rightarrow Pick up customers to join us infront of T oyoko Inn hotel 1, Busan Station 13:00 (Stop those places depending on 3 days tour tourists) \rightarrow Jagalchi Market and BIFF Square, Busan's old downtown with seafood \rightarrow Haeundae Beachand Dongbaek Park \rightarrow Transfer to Gyeongju (100Km/ 1hr30min) \rightarrow Check in a hotel.

Hotel stay: Commodore Hotel Gyeongju or similar (B)

Day 4 / Gyeongju – Andong – Pyeongchang

Breakfast at your hotel \rightarrow Seokguram Grotto(UNESCO), constructed by Kim Dae-Seong during the reign ofKing Gyeong-Deok (742-765) of the Silla Kingdom. \rightarrow Bulguksa Buddhist Temple(UNESCO) The beauty of thetemple itself and artistic touch of the stone relics are as awesome and fascinating as to be highly praised byvisitors from all over the world \rightarrow Move to Andong (170km/ 2hr 30min) \rightarrow Andong Hahoe Village(UNESCO)which has preserved the housing architecture and the village structure of the Joseon Dynasty. Moreover, theVillage was naturally formed with people who actually live there. It has become world-famous for the visit ofQueen Elizabeth II of The Great Britain. \rightarrow Move to Pyeongchang (234km/ 2hr 30min), 2018 Winter Olympic host city \rightarrow Check in a hotel.

Hotel stay: Ramada Hotel Pyeongchang or similar (B)

Day 5 / Pyeongchang – Mt. Seorak – Seoul

Breakfast at your hotel \rightarrow Drive around Venues of 2018 Winter Olympic Games \rightarrow Move to Sokcho(100km/ 1hr30min). Stop by Gangneung Hangho beach, BTS Bus station : Album Jackets : You never walk alone (If time is available). Visit Seoraksan National Park(UNESCO Biosphere Zone), Seoraksan National Park, the peaks of the Seoraksan Mountains break through the clouds while jade-like water flows through the valleys, creating breathtaking views and making this Korea's most famous national park. Due to the many rare species found here, UNESCO designated this national park a Biosphere Preservation District in 1982. *Cable car to Gwongeumseong Fortress (Optional for cable car USD20pp) \rightarrow Move to Seoul (195km/ 3hr 30min). Thelocation for arrival: The Donghwa Duty Free Shop Building. Estimated Arrival Time: 17:00

**During the peak season in October, the Seoraksan National Park will restrict buses and medium size busfor entries. Therefore, the bus must park at C District Square and you must walk 3.6km to the entrance from CDistrict Square. So please be aware of that we might not be able to visit Seoraksan National Park for this tour.

Arrive Seoul about 6pm at the drop off point: Donghwa Duty Free Shop Building at Gwanghwamun intersection. (B)
