## D 1: Arrive Dalian (Dinner) Hotel : Shangri-La Dalian

Pick up & transfer from Dalian airport or train station to hotel: visits to

**Xinghai Square:** (Square of the Sea of Stars) was built up in the year of 1993 in the southern beach scenic area of Dalian and has been regarded as the largest city square throughout Asia ever after. Covering an area of 1, 760, 000m<sup>2</sup>, it is twice as large as Tian'anmen Square., the most well-known landmark in Dalian's downtown area. **Binghai Road**, 32 kilometers long, running through 12 main sightseeing spots along the coastline, including Tiger Beach Ocean Park, Fu's houses estate, Xinghai Square, Mallet Island and so on. In Spring time, driving on the road, you can see a wide expanse of ocean water with reefs and islands in great variety of shapes on one side, and cherry blossoms on the other side. All of these make extremely beautiful scenery. **North Bridge:** This bridge was built to commemorate Dalian is the sister city with North Kyushu of Japan, while in North Kyushu, Daihokutei, a colorful, hexagonal Chinese pavilion was built, as a symbol of friendship and cultural exchange between China and Japan.

## D2: Dalian - Lvshun - Shenyang (B/L/D) Hotel : Shangri-La Shenyang

After breakfast, visit to Port of **Lvshun**, Lvshun City surrounds the lake-like structure clearly visible near the peninsular tip—the lake-like feature is the inner natural harbour of the port, a very well-sheltered and fortifiable harbour to 19th century eyes. In the afternoon, take 2 hours high speed train to Shenyang. Shenyang city tour and the 1 stpedestrian street, about 1500 meter long.

## D3: Shenyang - Changbaishan (B/L/D) Hotel : Crown Plaza Resort Changbaishan

**The Shenyang Imperial Palace** was built in the 10th year of Emperor Taizu's reign (1625). It is the only imperial building complex outside the Great Wall of China. It was built during three periods, namely, during the reigns of Nurhaci, Huang Taiji and Qianlong, and took 158 years to complete. **Former Residence of Zhang Xueliang**, A reformer sympathetic to nationalist ideas, he completed the official reunification of China by pledging loyalty to the Nationalist government, and used his powerful base to wield significant influence in the politics of the Nanjing decade. Private transfer to Shenyang train station. Take high-speed train Shenyang - Changbaishan (3hrs)

## D4: Changbaishan (B/L/D) Hotel : Crown Plaza Resort Changbaishan

Full Day Tour **Changbaishan Mountain (north slope)**, A classic geological wonder, where you can overlook the Heavenly Lake and take in the beautiful scenery. **Beauty Pine Park:** Changbai Mountain Beauty Pine Sky Corridor Bridge Park is a simple small park, where wild ducks in the lake chase and play leisurely. In this tourist-oriented Erdaobaihe town, you can feel the cool breeze and comfort during the journey.

**D5: Changbaishan– Jilin (B/L/D) Hotel :World Trade Winning Hotel Jilin**

Private transfer to Jilin , visit **Meteorite Museum**. River and near Changchun Bridge. And it is China's only purpose-built meteorite museum. The museum contains exhibits relating not only to meteorite falls in Jilin but a collection of space-rocks from China and the several other countries (including Meteorite No.1, the largest stone in the world). The museum not only showcases the rocks but also graphs, analysis and other information regarding meteorites.

**Beishan Park** located in downtown Jilin, the Beishan Park is also called “nine-dragon sacred ground”. With a history of more than 300 years, it was originally named Jiulong (nine dragons) Mountain and was considered as where dragons were originated. Emperors Kangxi and Qianlong of the Qing Dynasty both visited the mountain in their tour to East China. The legend of “nine dragon culture” makes the treasured place more mysterious.

**D6:Jilin – Changchun(B/L/D) Hotel :Wanda Vista Changchun**

Private transfer to Changchun Afternoon visit **Museum of the Imperial Palace of Manchukuo**. The museum captures a slice of 1930s Dong-Bei history under the Japanese military occupation. A tour of the palace gives an insight into Pu Yi and his family’s living quarters and into the working apparatus of his government and secretariat. Palace grounds are worth an exploration - charmingly quaint garden with fountain pool and an underground surprise, an imperial bunker, an air raid shelter constructed for the Manchukuo royal family. **Changchun Film Museum** is impressively located at the top of an attractive park drive. The film-related items included relics from CFC’s cinema making past - props largely military weapons and lots of old equipment, sound machines, old style cameras, film posters (war movies seem to have been the most popular genre) etc. Pictures and bios of Chinese film-makers, dubbers etc who had been prominent at CFC studios during its halcyon days.

**D7: Changchun – Harbin (B/L/D) Hotel: JW Marriott Harbin**

Transfer to Harbin, visit **Saint Sophia Cathedral** (exterior). The church is located on the corner of Touloung Street (Touloungjie) and Zhaolin Street. It stands at 53.3 meters (175 ft) tall, occupies an area of 721 square meters (0.18 acres), and is the perfect example of Russian Revival architecture. The main structure is laid out like a cross with the main hall topped with a huge green-tipped dome. Under the bright sun, the church and the square area it stands on look quite like Red Square in Moscow. **Stalin Park** locals and visitors alike congregate year-round in Stalin Park. The tree-lined promenade, dotted with statues, playgrounds, recreation clubs and cafes for the locals. The sandy banks of the Songhua River take on something of a beach atmosphere in summer, with boating ice-cream stands, sample snacks, beer and photo booths. **Central Street** or Zhongyang Street is a pedestrian street located in central Harbin, China. Measuring 1450 meters long, it is currently the longest pedestrian street in Asia and the only cobbled street in Harbin. It was built in 1898 by Russian constructors when the city was at its semi-colonial period. Architectures along the street are in various styles including eclectic, Baroque, Renaissance and modern.



**D8: Harbin (B/L/D) Hotel: JW Marriott Harbin**

Harbin is also home to the **Siberian Tiger Park**, a place where the breeding and conservation of Siberian Tigers takes place. It is China's 2nd largest Siberian tiger park. The site includes a museum, breeding areas, and pens for the other large cats. It is amazing to see a group of striped golden tigers walk and run together. Visitors to the park can view a few score Siberian tigers that are on exhibit up close through fences, see other large cats such as Bengal tigers, lions, pumas and several other kinds, ride in vans or small buses into a field where they run and may chase the vehicle or hop on it,

and help to feed the animals. **Harbin Grand Theater**, is situated on Harbin's Cultural Island -- a new arts hub by the Songhua River's north bank, which includes the Harbin Labor Recreation Center and Harbin Great Square, at the heart of the Sun Island Scenic Area, and in close proximity to Harbin's famous Siberian Tiger Park. Appearing as if sculpted by wind and water, the building seamlessly blends in with nature and the topography of the surrounding wetlands. **The Sun Island park** is the pride of the locals and the pursuit of visitors. You can embrace the white sand, blue water, green field, blooming flowers, and cool weather. In winter, the island covered with white snow presents another beauty. It becomes a paradise for ice-snow travel. Sun Island is used as the playground for various winter sports. Skiing, Hockey, skating, and sledding games are all organized her. **The Harbin Ice and Snow World** is one of the largest ice and snow theme parks in the world, with an area of 600,000 square meters. It is also the irreplaceable landmark of Harbin City and world-known ice and snow tourism brand. It features more than 2,000 ice sculptures, landscapes, ice castles, rides and stage shows. It is literally a man-made winter fairyland. It is seen as "Disneyland of Ice and Snow".

#### **D9: Harbin (B)**

Morning visit **Chateau Volga**. Volga Manor is located on the bank of Ashi River in Xiangfang District of Harbin City. Covering an area of 600,000m<sup>2</sup>, the manor is an amplification of the city's Russian influences. Now, the manor featuring 30 Russian-style buildings, has become a new tourist resort featuring wet lands, landscaped gardens, hotels, restaurants, and meeting venues, hosting events such as art exhibitions and performances. Private transfer to Harbin airport or train station for next destination:
