Day 1. Arrival Incheon Airport, meet by the local tour representative, transfer to the hotel in Seoul.

Day 2, Seoul whole day tour (B/L/D)

Breakfast in the hotel, Hanbok (Korean Traditional Costume) Experience, Gyeongbokgung Palace, Hanilkwan restaurant (Lunch) has been selected as a Seoul Future Heritage Site by the Seoul Metropolitan Government and as a Bib Gourmand in Seoul by the Michelin Guide for four years since 2017. **Bukchon Hanok Village, Cooking class for Korean Japchae, Nanta show, La Cantina restaurant (Dinner)**, selected as a Seoul Future Heritage Site, La Cantina has a classy atmosphere, and Samsung Group founder and Chairman Lee Byung-cheol used to visit often.

Day 3, DMZ Tour (B/L/D)

Breakfast in the hotel, DMZ tour typically refers to a tour of the Korean Demilitarized Zone (DMZ), which is a heavily fortified area that separates North Korea and South Korea. The DMZ is approximately 4 kilometers wide and stretches across the Korean Peninsula from the west coast to the east coast. **Imjingak Park** was built in 1972 with the hope that someday unification would be possible. Over 400 photos and documents showing the stark reality of North Korea are displayed in the North Korea Center of Unification Board. Outside Imjingak, there are 12 unique tanks and warcrafts on display that were used during the war. **The 3rd infiltration tunnel (Dorasan Observatory)**

was discovered in 1978 by South Korean forces. It spans over 1,635m in length, 2m in width, and 2m in height and is located 52km from Seoul. It was discovered in October 1978. Almost identical in structure to Tunnel II, the 1.635 kilometer-long tunnel, 1.95 meters high and 2.1 meters wide, penetrates 435 meters south of the Military Demarcation Line at a point only 4 kilometers south of the Truce Village of Panmunjom. It runs through bedrock at a depth of about 73 meters below ground. Capable of moving a full division per hour, plus their weapons, it is evidently designed for a surprise attack on Seoul. **Dora Observatory, Dorasan Station** 52 years of anticipation, waiting for the day when the two countries will be united once again. Dorasan station, the northernmost station in South Korea, has planned to connect the Gyongueisun(Line) and it will be linked to the European

continent via the Siberian Railway. **Shimgol Jeontong Doenjang restaurant (Lunch)**, a restaurant that actually makes traditional Korean soybean paste, cooks it, and serves it to customers, and **“All That Jazz” club (Dinner)** will be included in the itinerary today.

Day 4, Seoul City Tour (B/L/D)

Namsan Seoul Tower was the first multipurpose tower to be established in Korea, effectively incorporating a sightseeing observatory to a broadcasting tower, an iconic landmark of the city of Seoul. **National Museum of Korea** The National Museum of Korea houses a vast collection of over 420,000 artifacts from ancient times to the modern era. **Yukjeon Hoekwan restaurant (Lunch)**, its **famous dish** is crispy bulgogi. **Saturday Gugak Concert**, aims to collect, notate and preserve a museum and library of Korea’s traditional music heritage. **A walk at Cheonggyecheon Stream**, 11 km-long stream that runs through downtown Seoul, a restoration of the stream that was once there during the Joseon Dynasty (1392-1910). The stream starts from Cheonggye Plaza, a popular cultural arts venue, and passes under a total of 22 bridges before flowing into the Hangang River, with many attractions along the way. Dinner in the **Gwangjang Market**. first permanent market in Korea and continues to thrive as a popular tourist destination today.

Day 5 Tour ends. Transfer to Incheon airport (B)
