#### ARRIVAL HONG KONG – SHENZHEN (B/L/D)

Hotel: Crown Plaza Suites Landmark or similar (5 stars)

Meet and assist by local representative at Hong Kong airport, transfer to the border of Hong Kong, proceed to Shenzhen via Liantang Port. Visits to Ping An Finance Centre, the 2nd tallest building in China, the tallest building in Shenzhen. Shenzhen International Art Museum. Ride in the futuristic metro station: the Eye of Shenzhen. Lunch & dinner included.



### 🗓️ DAY 4

#### SHENZHEN – ZHONGSHAN – GUANGZHOU (B/L/D)

Hotel: Guangzhou New World Hotel or similar (5 stars)

Cross the Shenzhen–Zhongshan Link bridge-tunnel. Visit Nansha Marina and Baomo Garden. Explore Huangcheng Square, surrounded by landmarks. Enjoy Pearl River night cruise and magnificent views. Transfer back to Hotel after dinner.



### 🗓️ DAY 5

#### GUANGZHOU – KAIPING (B/L/D)

Hotel: Pan Tower International Hotel or similar (5 stars)

Visit Five Ram Statue in Yuexiu Park, Foshan Ancestral Hall, Huang Feihong Memorial Hall, Ip Man Hall. Enjoy Lion dance Kung Fu show. Explore Foshan Ningnan World—ancient buildings with modern shopping, leisure and food streets.



### 🗓️ DAY 6

#### KAIPING (UNESCO SITE) – TAISHAN (B/L/D)

Hotel: Taishan New World Hotel or similar (5 stars)

Visit Chikan Old Town Resort with Qilou buildings and street food. Explore Meijia Compound & Haikou Buwenhua Buildings, heritage of overseas Chinese. Visit The Floating Moon House, a showcase of rural village beauty in Taishan.



### 🗓️ DAY 7

#### TAISHAN – ZHONGSHAN – ZHUHAI (B/L/D)

Hotel: Double Tree by Hilton Zhuhai Hengqin or similar (5 stars)

Visit Zhan Yuan in Zhongshan. Cross Huangmaohai Sea-crossing Channel, winner of IBC recognition 2025. Visit The Lover's Road, Riyuebei Opera House Zhuhai, Sea & Sky Post House and the Ponto Legend in Hengqin.



### 🗓️ DAY 8

#### ZHUHAI – MACAU (B/D)

Hotel: Sofitel Macau at Ponte 16 or similar (5 stars)

Travel via Hengqin port to Macau. Visit Ruinas de Sao Paulo (UNESCO site), Lotus Square, Rua Do Cunha, Handover Gifts Museum, The Spectacle of MGM Macau, Tree of Prosperity Wynn Macau, and the Taipa House.



### 🗓️ DAY 9

#### MACAU – HONG KONG (B/L)

Hotel: New World Millennium Hong Kong Hotel or similar (5 stars)

Cross the 55km Hong Kong–Zhuhai–Macau Bridge, the longest bridge-cum-tunnel sea crossing in the world. Arrive in Hong Kong. After lunch and check-in, free time to explore Avenue of Stars, Victoria Harbour, K11 Art District and more.

### DAY 10 HONG KONG ISLAND ½ DAYS (B/D)

Hotel: New World Millennium Hong Kong Hotel or similar (5 stars)

After breakfast, visits: Nan Lian Garden, a meticulously landscaped park that also follows the Tang dynasty design principles, and Chi Lin Nunnery provide a serene oasis at the base of the mountains in Diamond Hill. Victoria Peak with Tram ride, the Central-Mid Levels Escalators, Tai Kwun (the building is over 180 years old, the former Central Police station, now is cultural heart of Hong Kong.), transfer back to hotel, lunch on your own, free to try the cafes opposite to the Millennium Hotel. After some rest, Dinner will be arranged nearby.



### DAY 11 SAI KUNG ½ DAY TOUR (B/L/D)

Hotel: New World Millennium Hong Kong Hotel or similar (5 stars)

After breakfast, Visit to Yim Tin Tsai, a small island, boasts a charming natural environment and a Hakka village with a rich history of over 300 years, located within the inner water of Sai Kung, visitors can explore Hong Kong' past and present with visits to the UNESCO-listed salt pans and an exploration for its modern art scene. A seafood lunch in one of the restaurants in Sai Kung, where is famous for seafood and fishing port in Hong Kong. Transfer back to Hotel for a rest. After the farewell dinner, transfer back to hotel and free on your own to enjoy the rest of your time in Hong Kong.

After breakfast, please pack well, and check out the hotel at 11 am or before. Tour ends. Have a nice and safe flight back home or to your next destination.
