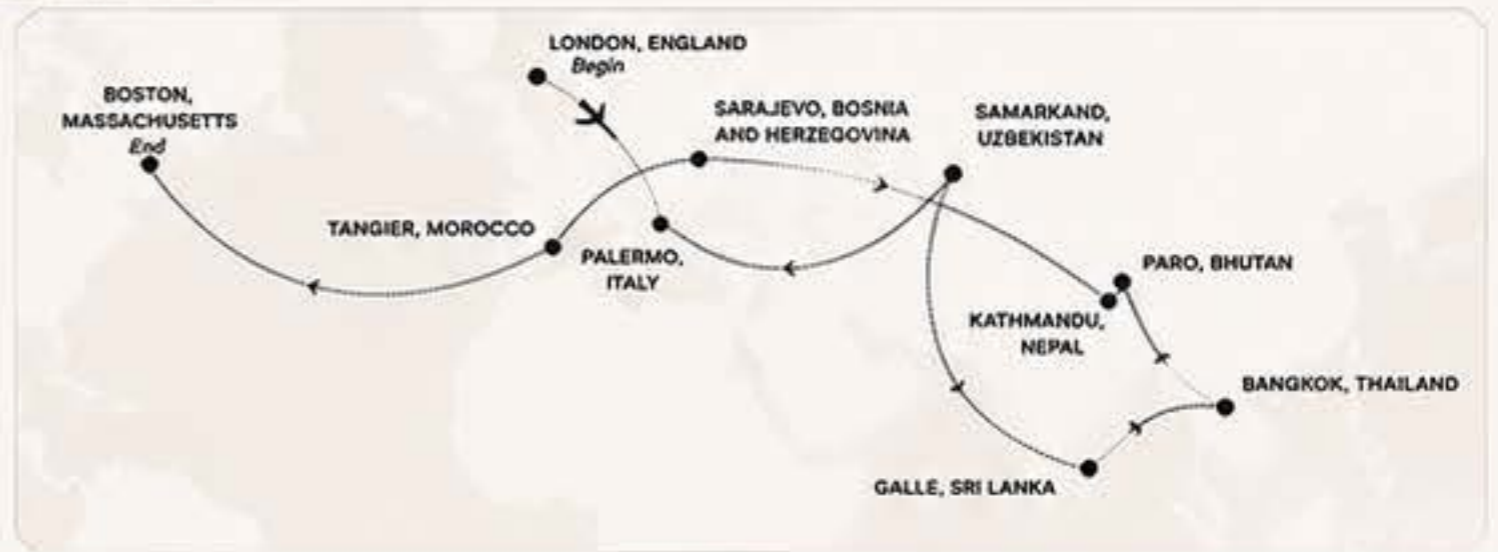
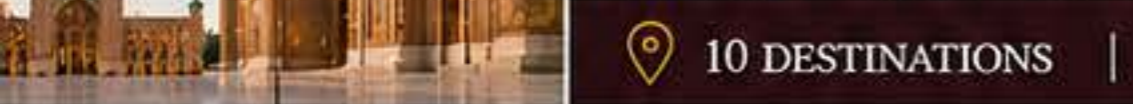


Crossroads of Civilization

London, England | Nov 1–2

Galle, Sri Lanka | Nov 7–10
Cape Weligama <THREE NIGHTS>
 On Sri Lanka's southern coast, Galle has long been a historic gateway along the trading routes of the Indian Ocean—its terraced tea fields and colorful fish market revealing traditions rooted in centuries of maritime exchange. Inland, take a private helicopter transfer to the nearby Sigiriya Rock Fort and Dambulla Cave Temples to explore two of the oldest and best-preserved sites in the region.



Bangkok, Thailand | Nov 10–13
