DAY 1 | JAN 17



VANCOUVER – HONG KONG – HANOI

Fly to Hanoi, the capital city of Vietnam, via Hong Kong with Cathay Pacific Airways.

DAY 2 | JAN 18



ARRIVAL IN HANOI (L, D)

Enjoy a cyclo ride through the Old Quarter and a leisurely stroll around Hoan Kiem Lake. Visit Ngoc Son Temple, followed by a light lunch at a local restaurant. Experience Vietnam's unique Water Puppet Show, a tradition dating back over 1,000 years, then enjoy a welcome dinner featuring the rich flavours of authentic Vietnamese cuisine.

DAY 3 | JAN 19



HANOI – HA LONG BAY OVERNIGHT CRUISE (B, L, D)

After breakfast, depart for Ha Long Bay, a UNESCO World Heritage Site renowned for its spectacular limestone islands and emerald waters. Begin the Paradise cruise with a welcome drink and delicious lunch while exploring the natural beauty of Ha Long Bay. Activities may include visiting a limestone cave, kayaking or a bamboo boat ride, a Vietnamese cooking demonstration, night-time squid fishing and relaxing at the bar. Activities vary according to the cruise arrangement. Cruise operation is subject to weather conditions and local government safety advice.

HA LONG BAY – BAT TRANG POTTERY VILLAGE – HANOI (LB, BRUNCH, D)

After a light breakfast, continue cruising through Ha Long Bay's magnificent limestone seascape and breathtaking scenery. Join a morning excursion or simply relax onboard before returning to the pier. A farewell brunch will be served. Visit Bat Trang Pottery Village, a traditional craft village with more than 700 years of history. Return to Hanoi and transfer to the hotel after dinner.

DAY 5 | JAN 21



HANOI – QUANG PHU CAU INCENSE VILLAGE – TAM COC – BICH DONG – HANOI (B, L, D)

After breakfast, visit Quang Phu Cau Incense Village to discover traditional incense making and admire colourful displays of incense sticks. Continue to Ninh Binh, known as “Ha Long Bay on Land” for its spectacular limestone mountains, winding rivers and picturesque countryside. Enjoy a leisurely sampan boat ride through Tam Coc, where the Ngo Dong River meanders through lush rice fields and passes beneath a series of natural caves. After lunch, visit Bich Dong Pagoda, offering beautiful views of the surrounding landscape and a glimpse into Vietnam’s rich Buddhist heritage. After dinner, return to the hotel.

DAY 6 | JAN 22



HANOI – HUE (B, L, D)

After breakfast, visit a traditional Hanoi café to experience the city’s EGG COFFEE, one of Hanoi’s most iconic culinary specialities. Next, visit the Temple of Literature, Vietnam’s first national university. Continue to Ba Dinh Square for an outside view of the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, followed by the One Pillar Pagoda, Tran Quoc Pagoda and West Lake, the largest freshwater lake in Hanoi. After lunch, transfer to Noi Bai International Airport and fly to Hue. After dinner, transfer to the hotel.

DAY 7 | JAN 23



HUE – DA NANG – HOI AN (B, L, D)

After breakfast, explore Hue, the former imperial capital of Vietnam and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Visit the magnificent Imperial Citadel, once the political and cultural heart of the Nguyen Dynasty for over 140 years. Continue to Thien Mu Pagoda, the iconic seven-storey pagoda overlooking the tranquil Perfume River. Visit the elegant Tomb of Emperor Khai Dinh, remarkable for its fusion of traditional Vietnamese architecture and European influences. Depart for Hoi An via the scenic Hai Van Pass, with breathtaking views of Lang Co Bay. In the late afternoon, enjoy a leisurely walking tour through Hoi An Ancient Town. After dinner, transfer to the hotel.

DAY 8 | JAN 24



HOI AN – BA NA HILLS – DA NANG (B, L, D)

After breakfast, visit Ba Na Hills and enjoy a scenic cable car ride. Explore the world-famous Golden Bridge and the charming French Village with its beautiful gardens. After lunch, descend by cable car and continue to My Khe Beach. Next, visit Dragon Bridge, Da Nang’s iconic landmark, renowned for its impressive architecture and views of the Han River and vibrant city skyline. Transfer to the hotel.

DAY 9 | JAN 25



DA NANG – HO CHI MINH CITY (B, L, D)

After breakfast, enjoy free time to relax. Check out and visit the Marble Mountains, renowned for their ancient pagodas, fascinating caves and panoramic viewpoints overlooking Da Nang. Fly to Ho Chi Minh City. After dinner, transfer to the hotel.

DAY 10 | JAN 26



HO CHI MINH CITY – MY THO (MEKONG DELTA) – HO CHI MINH CITY (B, L, D)

After breakfast, visit My Tho, Vietnam's rice bowl, where life revolves around water, orchards and winding river channels. Visit Vinh Trang Pagoda, an elegant Buddhist temple beautifully blending Vietnamese, Khmer and European architectural influences. Board a private boat and cruise along the Tien River, one of the main branches of the Mekong River. Along the way, see floating fish farms and the impressive Rach Mieu Bridge spanning the river. Continue to Thoi Son Islet, a tranquil island known for its fruit orchards and traditional rural lifestyle. Visit a honey farm, sample honey tea and hear stories about beekeeping. Travel along village paths by electric cart, passing coconut groves and traditional houses. In a garden orchard, sample seasonal tropical fruits and enjoy a live performance of "Don Ca Tai Tu," a UNESCO-recognized form of Southern Vietnamese folk music. A highlight of the day is a peaceful hand-rowed sampan ride through narrow canals shaded by water coconut palms, offering a glimpse of the serene beauty of Delta life. Continue to Ben Tre Province, the Land of Coconut, and visit a local workshop to see how coconut candy and rice paper are made. After dinner, return to the hotel.

DAY 11 | JAN 27



HO CHI MINH CITY – CU CHI – VUNG TAU (B, L, D)

After breakfast, proceed to the Cu Chi Tunnels, a network of tunnels more than 200 kilometres long and three to eight metres deep. Dug during the war, the tunnels are located approximately 75 kilometres northwest of the city. After lunch, transfer to Vung Tau, a coastal city renowned for its colonial heritage and beautiful beaches. Visit White Palace (Bach Dinh), a former French colonial residence overlooking the bay. Enjoy a relaxing walk along the seaside promenade before checking in at the hotel. After dinner, transfer to the hotel.

Hotel: The Imperial Vung Tau or similar

DAY 12 | JAN 28



VUNG TAU – HO CHI MINH CITY (B, L, D)

After breakfast, climb over 800 steps to the iconic Christ the King Statue, one of the largest statues of Jesus in Asia, and enjoy panoramic views over the city. Visit Nghinh Phong Cape for spectacular views of the East Sea. After lunch, return to Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam's vibrant commercial and cultural hub. Visit Reunification Palace, Notre-Dame Cathedral Basilica of Saigon (outside view), Saigon Central Post Office and Ben Thanh Market. After dinner, enjoy free time to explore Ho Chi Minh City.

DAY 1 | JAN 29



HO CHI MINH CITY – SIEM REAP (D)

Suggested flight: Vietnam Airlines VN813, SGN–SAI, 16:40–17:40.

Upon arrival in Siem Reap, meet your local guide and transfer to the hotel for check-in.
The remainder of the evening is at leisure.

DAY 2 | JAN 30



ANGKOR ARCHAEOLOGICAL PARK (B, L, D)

After breakfast at the hotel, enjoy a full-day exploration of the magnificent Angkor Archaeological Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the world's greatest archaeological treasures. Enter the ancient city of Angkor Thom through its impressive South Gate before exploring the remarkable Bayon Temple, renowned for its towering stone faces. Continue to the Terrace of the Elephants, the Terrace of the Leper King and atmospheric Ta Prohm Temple, where giant tree roots intertwine with centuries-old ruins, creating one of Angkor's most iconic scenes. After lunch, discover breathtaking Angkor Wat, the largest religious monument in the world and the finest masterpiece of Khmer architecture. Admire its magnificent galleries, intricate bas-reliefs and iconic five towers while learning about the rich history of the Khmer Empire. Conclude the day with a spectacular sunset from Phnom Bakheng, offering panoramic views over the Angkor complex, subject to weather conditions and visitor regulations. After dinner, transfer back to the hotel.

DAY 3 | JAN 31



TONLE SAP LAKE – ARTISANS ANGKOR – SIEM REAP (B, L, D)

After breakfast, depart for Chong Kneas Floating Village on Tonle Sap Lake, Southeast Asia's largest freshwater lake. Board a local boat to explore the unique floating community, where homes, schools, shops and daily life thrive on the water, providing fascinating insight into the local way of life. Return to Siem Reap and visit Artisans Angkor, a renowned workshop dedicated to preserving Cambodia's traditional arts and crafts. Observe skilled artisans creating exquisite stone carvings, wood sculptures, silk products and lacquerware using centuries-old techniques. After lunch, visit Wat Bo, one of Siem Reap's oldest and most respected pagodas, known for its beautiful 19th-century murals depicting scenes from the Reamker, the Cambodian version of the Ramayana. Continue to the Old Market (Psar Chas), where you can browse a vibrant selection of local handicrafts, souvenirs, spices and Cambodian specialties. Enjoy free time to explore the surrounding cafés, boutiques and lively riverside atmosphere. After dinner, transfer to the hotel.

DAY 4 | FEB 01



SIEM REAP – DEPARTURE (B)

After breakfast at the hotel, enjoy free time at leisure until transfer to Siem Reap–Angkor International Airport for your onward flight.

Suggested flight: Bangkok Airways PG906, departing Siem Reap at 13:20 for Bangkok, with onward travel to Hong Kong for a stopover or an immediate connection from Hong Kong back to Vancouver.
